Instruction Sheet for P Trap Drain Tube Kit

Kit Contains:

- 1 P-Trap Drain Tube
- 1 Drain Valve
- 1 Instruction Sheet

Tools Needed:

1/4" Nut Driver
Tape Measure / Marker
Utility Knife

AWARNING



Electrical Shock Hazard

Disconnect power before servicing. Replace all parts and panels before operating.

Failure to do so can result in death or electrical shock.

- 1. Unplug refrigerator or disconnect power.
- 2. Remove the machine compartment cover.
- 3. Determine your product type and the parts required:

For Top Freezer models, proceed to step 4.

For French Door with Bottom Freezer models, skip to step 5.

- 4. For **Top Freezer models**, use the included drain valve. Discard the p-trap drain tube included, it won't be needed.
 - Remove and replace the drain valve without modifications.
 See Figure 1.

IMPORTANT: Be sure to remove any ice blockage/obstructions in the freezer behind the evaporator cover and from drain tube.



- b. When complete, skip ahead to step 9.
- 5. For French Door with Bottom Freezer models, use the included p-trap drain tube (following steps 5a OR 5b) Discard the drain valve included, it won't be needed.
 - a. If the product originally had a p-trap drain tube, proceed to step 8, to remove and replace the p-trap drain tube without modifications.
 - If the product originally had a drain valve, complete the following steps to shorten the drain tube extending below the cabinet.
- 6. Remove existing drain trough funnel (if applicable) and drain valve from the drain tube and discard. See Figure 1.

IMPORTANT: Be sure to remove any ice blockage/obstructions in the freezer behind the Evaporator cover and from drain tube.

Measure 46mm (1 3/4") from the bottom of the drain tube, make a mark and use a utility knife to cut the drain tube. See Figure 2.



8. Assemble the P Trap to the drain tube, making sure water will fall into the drain tray. See Figure 3.



- 9. Replace machine compartment cover.
- 10. Replace all parts and panels.
